5. Research paper “Meta-analysis of TNBC prevalence in India” accepted in journal of American Society of Clinical Oncology (ASCO) – JCO-Global Oncology.

Research team at Prashanti Cancer Care Mission and its Centre for Translational Cancer Research in a joint initiative with IISER Pune has compiled a systematic review of 34 Indian studies on breast cancer and triple negative breast cancer (TNBC) prevalence. The comprehensive review is accepted for publication in a reputed journal of American Society of Clinical Oncology (ASCO) – JCO-Global Oncology.

6. One-year internship completion by Ms. Pradhan in CTCR – a joint initiative between PCCM and IISER, Pune

Ms. Sigma Pradhan, a Master’s student from IISER-Kolkata has completed one-year internship successfully with Center for Translational Cancer Research in a joint initiative of Prashanti Cancer Care Mission with IISER Pune. Ms. Pradhan’s thesis involved uncovering mechanisms of oncogenic progression of HER2 positive breast cancers and involvement of novel markers.

7. Six months internship completion by Ms. Sharma in CTCR – a joint initiative between PCCM and IISER, Pune

Ms. Arundhati Sharma, a Master’s student from Amity University, Noida has completed six months internship with Center for Translational Cancer Research in a joint initiative of Prashanti Cancer Care Mission with IISER Pune. Ms. Sharma’ work involved standardising IHC technique to detect a novel stem-cells marker in TNBC tumours.
