### 2. Ms. Laleh Busheri was invited to be a speaker at TEDx Talk

Ms. Laleh Busheri was invited to be a speaker at the TEDx Talk hosted by Lexicon International School, Wagholi on December 19, 2020. She narrated the journey of Prashnati from its idea and inception. She talked about the need for breast cancer awareness in the community. Different activities involving people like Marathons, Symposiums, screening drives in slums through well-equipped mammography buses have been a part of Prashanti's community-based work. She went through the journey of identifying the need of having a centre of affordable excellence where people from all classes of the society would have access to world class treatment. This thought created Orchids Breast Health, India's first stand alone breast cancer centre, with state-of-art equipment, unmatched anywhere in the country at that time. Later, she went on to explain how the the vacuum in the field of breast surgeries was identified and Oncoplastic training program was initiated by Dr. C.B. Koppiker. This program enables surgeons all over the world to be trained for breast oncoplastic procedures and thus has reduced the rate of mastectomies. Over 70 surgeons in Asia have been a part of the M.Ch. Breast Oncoplasty program which is in collaboration with East Anglia University, UK. She also talked about the formation of Pink Support Group, which is a group by the patients and for the patients. The group has been a family to each of the patients and has provided them with moral support and strength to deal with the disease. Ms. Laleh Busheri also narrated inspirational stories of survivorship and humanity that have motivated her to dream bigger and better.

Mrs Rashmi Patel was a highly educated professional and yet a kind, compassionate and gentle lady. She emotionally counselled and financially helped innumerable people who came to her for advice and aid. She devoted her life to social service and turned around the management of several trusts to make them more transparent and efficient.

In the year 2016, while her daughter was going through expensive treatment for breast cancer, Mrs Rashmi Patel decided to initiate a fund with Prashanti Cancer Care Mission, for Herceptin (trastuzumab) an expensive medicine that is the gold standard in HER2+ cancer treatment, for those who could not afford it.

Up to January 15, 2021 Mrs. Rashmi Patel has been able to save lives of 77 young women suffering from breast cancer. In her remembrance, we would like to create a mass scale awareness among the community to be able to pick up early breast cancers so as to avoid high mortality rates and morbidities.





#### 5. Genome India Project calls for healthy volunteers

Genome India National Mission Project is a government-initiated project aimed at cataloging genomic variations in healthy Indian population across different ethnicities. CTCR is one of the 12 clinical sample collection sites across the nation for this project . We started recruiting volunteers since August 2020 and have achieved our given targets even in the pandemic times. We appeal healthy volunteers and Trios (both parents and children) from Maratha, Deshastha Brahmin, Koknastha Brahmin and Koli sub-ethnicities to actively participate in this project.

# **Call for Healthy Volunteers for National Research Project**

## GenomeIndia: Cataloguing the Genetic Variations in Indians

Centre for Translational Cancer Research (CTCR : a joint initiative of IISER Pune and Prashanti Cancer Care Mission) is conducting an ethically approved, medically supervised research study in Maharashtra at the behest of Department of Biotechnology, Government of India.

This national mission project aims to establish a reference genome specific to Indian population by whole genome sequencing of 10,000 healthy individuals representing various Indian sub-groups. This research will lay the foundation for making personalized medicine a reality in India in near future and contribute to the global genomics knowledge base.

#### You are eligible for this study if you are:

- A male or female
- Of age group 18-70 years
- A healthy individual with no overtly major health condition
- From the Maharashtrian community (i.e., Maratha, Deshastha Brahmin, Koknastha Brahmin, Koli)
- Willing to provide informed written consent

For eligible study volunteers, we will:

- Arrange phone counseling session
- Organize local recruitment camps with appropriate COVID-19 risk management
- Collect health-related data
- Collect anthropometry parameters\*
- Collect Blood samples (10 ml)\*
- Utilize **30-40 mins** of your time only once By trained paramedical professionals only
- Being a study participant will ensure your receive a free complete health check up with signed laboratory reports.
- There is no cost involved for participants for any study related activities.
- No monetary compensation will be provided for being a study volunteer.
- All safety precautions for COVID-19 risk will be followed as per Government of India guidelines.
