2. Dr. Koppiker invited as a speaker in a comprehensive course on management of cancers

Dr. Koppiker was invited as a speaker to talk about Introduction to Breast Cancer, diagnostic symptoms, Investigations and Allopathic treatment modalities on May 30, 2021. The course of management of cancers focuses on the homeopathic approach in oncology. Over 150 individuals have registered for the lecture.



3. Breast Cancer Biobank at a Single Institution in an Urban Setting in India: Tumor Characteristics and Survival Outcomes manuscript accepted for publishing in Cancer Treatment and Research Communications journal

PCCM upon its establishment has been on forefront to streamline facilities like clinical data and tissue biobank, the first of its kind in Pune city. The tissue and data biobank has been established in 2018 to build a retrospective cohort of breast cancer patients that have been diagnosed and treated at PCCM. The biobank holds clinical history, diagnostic images, treatment and follow-up information along with FFPE tissue specimens of tumour, adjacent normal and in few cases, contralateral normal breast tissue. Detailed family history and germline mutational profiles of eligible and consenting patients and their relatives are deposited in the biobank.

The biobank has aided initiation of Centre for Translational Research (CTCR); a joint initiative of PCCM with IISER Pune, one of the eminent academic institutes on the country. The biobank proves as a valuable resource to evaluate and understand breast cancer aetiology in an Indian cohort and to the breast cancer research community at large.

A comprehensive data and tissue biobanking task initiated by clinical and research teams at CTCR is now accepted in an international, reputed and peer reviewed journal Cancer Treatment and Research Communications of European Elsevier publications.

When I noticed a lump in my left breast I ignored it for some time and then something told me to go get it checked up, which I did so in Dubai sometime end July 2018. Of course after a series of check-ups and tests it was confirmed as cancer. I was advised to get it operated immediately. My cousin in Pune who is a cancer survivor told me about Dr. Koppiker. I called him and he assured me that I was in safe hands. Then I asked him an awkward question. Will I be disfigured. His answer Ma'am we are not in the business of disfiguring anyone but in curing them.

Dr. Koppiker and his team made all the necessary arrangements at Ruby Hall where the surgery would be done. After some tests/ mri etc the surgery was scheduled for 18th august 2018. Having been sedated I felt nothing and came out of it safe and sound. Dr. Koppiker taking into consideration my age recommended radiation in a very discreet manner and I opted for that.

My very first visit to Orchids impressed me and gave me a sense of reassurance. The staff especially Nurse Smeeta went out of their way to make us welcome. I met the good doctor's wife and learnt from her about the charitable work they do. I believe for every paying patient they do breast cancer surgery free for a deserving lady. Ms. Laleh Busheri herself took me around their clinic and showed me their whole infrastructure. I also met another lady who told me how the Koppikers invited all their patients annually and treat them to a party/dinner at their own hone. Wow indeed.

Its two years now and Alhamdullilah I am quite fine and fit, thanks to Dr. Koppiker and his team at Orchids.
