4. PCCM manuscript on cancer care through the pandemic accepted for publication in 'South Asian Journal of Cancer Care'

The pandemic with COVID-19 has affected healthcare system, especially changing the routine practices meant for chronic illnesses such as cancer. Based on the national and international guidelines and in the medical interest of cancer patients undergoing treatment at Orchids Clinic, PCCM decided to continue providing emergency support and treatment support to its patients mainly affected with breast cancer. The methodology adopted here for care and management of the cancer patients can serve as a guiding principle for cancer care units in the country. With these efforts, the clinic was able to continue with the optimal care and treatment for the breast cancer patients despite the pandemic situation. The measures and methods employed at Prashanti Cancer Care Mission are accepted for publication in 'South Asian Journal of Cancer Care' and will serve as a reference to follow.

When I noticed a lump in my left breast I ignored it for some time and then something told me to go get it checked up, which I did so in Dubai sometime end July 2018. Of course after a series of check-ups and tests it was confirmed as cancer. I was advised to get it operated immediately. My cousin in Pune who is a cancer survivor told me about Dr. Koppiker. I called him and he assured me that I was in safe hands. Then I asked him an awkward question. Will I be disfigured. His answer Ma'am we are not in the business of disfiguring anyone but in curing them.

Dr. Koppiker and his team made all the necessary arrangements at Ruby Hall where the surgery would be done. After some tests/ mri etc the surgery was scheduled for 18th august 2018. Having been sedated I felt nothing and came out of it safe and sound. Dr. Koppiker taking into consideration my age recommended radiation in a very discreet manner and I opted for that.

My very first visit to Orchids impressed me and gave me a sense of reassurance. The staff especially Nurse Smeeta went out of their way to make us welcome. I met the good doctor's wife and learnt from her about the charitable work they do. I believe for every paying patient they do breast cancer surgery free for a deserving lady. Ms. Laleh Busheri herself took me around their clinic and showed me their whole infrastructure. I also met another lady who told me how the Koppikers invited all their patients annually and treat them to a party/dinner at their own hone. Wow indeed.

Its two years now and Alhamdullilah I am quite fine and fit, thanks to Dr. Koppiker and his team at Orchids.
