1. IT WAS A PROUD MOMENT FOR PUNE TO HAVE DR. C.B. KOPPIKER INVITED TO DELIVER A KEYNOTE LECTURE AT THE SCHOOL OF ONCOPLASTIC SURGERY (SOS), USA ALONGSIDE **THE WORLD'S PIONEERS**

The course was conducted between February 8-10, 2019 at Newport Beach, CA, USA. SOS is a premier institute in the US which imparts advanced training in Breast Oncoplastic Surgery. In addition to the keynote, Dr. Koppiker demonstrated novel surgical techniques using cadaveric dissections. This had also been covered in the Los Angeles papers.

Other new international faculty include:

- Vincenzo Giovinazzo, M.D., consultant surgeon in plastic, reconstruction and aesthetic surgery at Institute du Sein and Clinic Rhena, Strasbourg, France
- · Andrea Manconi, plastic surgeon at the European Institute of Oncology, University of Sassari, Milan, Italy
- Angelo do Carma Silva Matthes, former coordinator of Gynecology and Obstetrics at the University of Ribeirao Preto (UNAERP), São Paolo, Brazil.

The course's keynote address at the February school will be delivered by worldrenowned surgeon Melvin Silverstein, M.D., the pioneer of oncoplastic breastconserving surgery in the U.S. Dr. Silverstein is the Medical Director of the Hoag Breast Center and holds the Gross Family Foundation Endowed Chair in Oncoplastic Breast Surgery in Newport Beach.

An additional keynote address will be given by Chaitanyanand B. Koppiker, M.S., M.D., a leading oncoplastic surgeon and Medical Director of Orchids Breast Health Center, in Pune, India. In addition to establishing the first integrated cancer center in Pune (Budhrani Cancer Institute at the Inlaks and Budhrani Hospital), Dr. Koppiker also founded an International School of Oncoplastic Surgery, which has held several international workshops and conferences.

The School of Oncoplastic Surgery provides participants with a variety of hands-on learning opportunities. These include an anatomy lab with cadavers to practice essential oncoplastic techniques and a live model workshop where attendees learn

It was a proud moment for Pune when renowned Indian breast cancer sur-geon Dr CB Koppiker, medical direc-tor, Orchids Breast Health, Pune, was in demonstrate nowl surgical techniques using cadaveric dissections at the School of Oncoplastic Surgery (SOS) in Los An-geles, America on February 8-10. The Koppiker has pioneered breast on-coplastic surgery in India since 2011, and established an oncoplastic unit through orchid's Breast Health. He has innovat-ed various techniques to drastically re-duce costs. Breast oncoplastic surgery (BOS) is a new paradigm in breast sur-gery that avoids unnecessary mastec-tomies, and restores the breast shape and size, while ensuring good cosmesis tomies, and restores the breast shape and size, while ensuring good cosmesis in a single surgery, leading to enhanced self-esteem and improved quality of life. He has done more than 1,300 on-coplastic surgeries till date. Due to the oncoplastic approach, more than 75 per cent of the patients save their breasts and the 25 per cent who need breast removal can have it reconstructed



90 per cent of the time. This rate of con-version to reconstruction is one of the highest in the world. The average in America and the UK is 40 per cent and 60 America and the UK is 30 per cent and 80 per cent respectively whereas in the rest of India it's five per cent. While the in-surance schemes reimburse the costs of reconstruction in the UK and America, that's not the case in India. However, Dr Koppiker's unit has made the procedure cost effective to suit the Indian context as well well

Dr Koppiker has also been awarded a faculty position in the University of East

Anglia UK and the American School of Oncoplastic surgery Recognizing the need to train more surgeons in the BOS techniques. Dr Koppiker joined hands with senior BOS faculty from the Uni-versity of East Anglia (UEA), in 2012 to conduct hands on training workshops and International conferences for Asian surgeons. Orchids Breast Health has also launched an academic degree pro-gram, M Ch in Breast Oncoplasty (of fered by UEA), which is the only course in Asia that offers cutting edge training in the niche field of oncoplasty and re constructive surgery. This training pro-gram will help create a workforce of well-trained oncoplastic surgeons, which will benefit breast cancer affected women all over Asia.
